Pursuant to Section 8-228 of the Franklin Municipal Code, and the Beer Board having reason to believe that the above holder of a Franklin beer permit has violated the provisions of the State Beer law and the ordinances of the City of Franklin, you are hereby notified to appear before the Franklin Beer Board on **Monday, November 7, 2022, at 4:30 p.m., in the City Hall Boardroom at the City of Franklin City Hall** and show cause why your license should not be suspended or revoked, or that you receive a fine, for such violation. The incident upon which this citation is based occurred on August 19, 2021, in Franklin, Tennessee.

The Chairman of the Beer Board is authorized to compel the attendance of witnesses by subpoena issued by the Clerk of the City Court. At the hearing, the Board will hear evidence both in support of the charges and on behalf of the permittee. The City intends to present the following facts into evidence:

1. On August 19, 2021, the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission (“TABC”) conducted a minor compliance check at the Residence Inn located at 8078 Berry Farms Crossings. At that time the permittee sold a 12-ounce bottle of Bud Light to a TABC confidential informant, who is 19 years old. The identification of the informant was checked. The event was witnessed by a TABC Special Agent.

2. The permittee’s employee was issued a regulatory citation by the TABC and admitted to the violation (*See Attached Regulatory Citation*).

3. These activities constitute making or allowing any sale of beer to a person under 21 years of age, in violation of Section 8-226 (5) of the Franklin Municipal Code.

You may request the issuance of subpoenas for any witness, examine City records prior to the hearing concerning the alleged violation, and appear personally, with legal counsel if you desire, to contest the charges, cross-examine witnesses, and generally make whatever defense you believe appropriate. Please note that it is **improper** to contact the members of the Beer Board prior to the hearing.

After the hearing, if the charges are sustained by the evidence, the Board has the discretion to revoke or suspend your permit, issue a reprimand, and to impose conditions upon your permit to deter future violations. The Board also has the option, in lieu of taking such action, of offering the permit holder the option of paying civil penalties. If you are a certified Responsible Vendor and wish to have that be considered, you are required to submit proof of such certification to the Beer Board no later than five (5) days prior to the hearing.

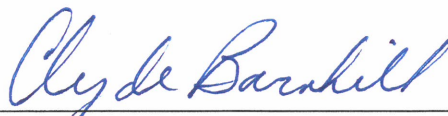

The event was witnessed by a TABC Special Agent.

2. The permittee’s employee was issued a criminal complaint by the TABC and was given 10 days to report to the Williamson County Jail (*See Attached Criminal Complaint; Affidavit and Narrative*).

3. The permittee’s employee did not plead not guilty to the charge. Instead, the permittee’s employee chose to request diversion from the Court, and was sentenced to perform 16 hours of public service work, pay a \$150 donation to St. Jude’s Children’s Hospital, and acquire no new criminal charges for six months.
