Alderman Hanson asked Mr. Powell to tell the Committee about the organization. The Foundation operates under D/B/A Autism Career Training, and they provide independent living skills, pre-employment, and employment skills to young adults and adults on the autism spectrum. Songs for the Spectrum is their largest event of the year where they fundraise between 40-50% of their annual budget. They are working with three different catering companies to get quotes for the event with licensed bartenders, and they have already acquired liquor licenses from the State of Tennessee. They have an insurance policy in place for the event as well.

A motion was made by Alderman Potts, seconded by Alderman Hanson, to Approve the Permit. The motion passed unanimously.

Edley's Berry Farms Alcohol Service Training Requirements

- All Team Members that serve alcohol must have a valid server permit from the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission pursuant to Tenn. Code. Ann. § 57-3-704. This permit must be carried on their person at all times while serving alcohol. A copy must also be on file with the restaurant. Team Members are responsible for renewing the permit as required every five years.
 - This requires a five (5) course with a trainer certified pursuant to Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission Chapter 0100-08 Rules for Professional Alcohol Server Training.
 - The following topics are included in the course:
 - The effect of alcohol on the human body, including a review of Blood Alcohol Content (BAC)
 - Factors affecting the absorption of alcohol
 - Behavioral effects of alcohol, interaction and
 - Combined effects of mixing alcohol with legal and illegal drugs
 - Identification of possible problem drinkers
 - Handling guests in a non-confrontational manner
 - Identifying situations where manager intervention is appropriate
 - Review of current Tennessee rules and regulations
 - Review of acceptable proof of age – Prior to alcohol service corporate policy is that all guests must present valid government issued photo identification, regardless of age.
- The rules of the Franklin Beer Board will be reviewed in-house during the training process.
- Team members must also abide by the attached company Alcohol Policy included in our Team Member Handbook.

Alcohol Policy

Responsible Alcohol Service

All ERG staff are strictly prohibited from serving alcohol to anyone who is:

1. ALREADY INTOXICATED
2. UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE, or
3. ACTING UNSTABLE

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO STOP SERVICE AND COMMUNICATE TO YOUR MANAGER, FELLOW SERVERS/BARTENDERS, AND HOST STAFF IF SOMEONE INSIDE OUR BUSINESS MEETS ANY OF THESE CRITERIA.

If your job responsibilities include the serving or selling of alcoholic beverages, you are required to provide a valid copy of your Server Permit from the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission. If you have not previously obtained a Server Permit you will have a 30-day window to obtain the permit and provide ERG with a copy. If you cannot provide a valid copy of a Server Permit, you will not be permitted to work in any job function that involves the selling, serving or handling of alcoholic beverages.

You are required to have a copy of your valid Server Permit from the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission on file in the restaurant where you are working.

You are also required to have copy of your valid Server Permit from the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission on your person at all times when serving alcoholic beverages.

You will check the ID of anyone ordering an alcoholic beverage who appears to be UNDER the age of 50 years old. If they are a regular guest at your bar, personally known to the you and you have personally checked their ID in the past six months, you do not have to check their ID however, you must notify the Manager and other bartenders on duty that you have personally checked that person's ID in the past six months.

If a guest does not have an ID available and they appear to be OVER the age of 50 years old, your manager must give you approval to serve this guest.

If a guest does not have an ID available and they appear to be UNDER the age of 50 years old, you cannot serve them an alcoholic beverage. Your manager and other bartenders must be told of this incident so they will not serve this guest.

If a guest is ordering alcoholic beverages for other persons in the restaurant, they must show an ID for each guest receiving an alcoholic beverage.

It is one of your job duties to provide Responsible Alcohol Service to our patrons at all times and any violation may result in disciplinary action up to and including termination.

ORDINANCE 2022-49

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 202, OF THE
FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE RELATIVE TO DEFINITION OF PREMISES
FOR CONSUMPTION OF BEER**

WHEREAS, in order to promote the health, safety, human rights, prosperity, and general welfare of the people of Franklin, Tennessee, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen is authorized to prescribe regulations and standards to relative to the sale of beer within the City; and

WHEREAS, Tenn. Code Ann. § 57-4-101(p) was amended by 2018 Public Chapter 755 to allow for the overlap of premises designations for entities operating in the same building or facility and which are seeking licensing for on premises consumption; and

WHEREAS, in order to be clear and deliberate in the definitions provided in the Franklin Municipal Code that are applicable to the permitting of the sale of beer; an amendment to the Code is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen find that this action to be in the best interest of the City.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FRANKLIN BOARD OF MAYOR AND
ALDERMEN, AS FOLLOWS:**

SECTION I. That the Franklin Municipal Code, Title 8, Section 202, subsection (3) be amended as follows, with new text being underlined:

(3) Premises shall mean on the property owned, leased, or controlled by the permittee and so connected with the beer business in which the permittee is engaged as to form a component or integral part of it, including, but not limited to, the building and the parking areas surrounding it. Premises includes all decks, patios and other well-defined outdoor serving areas that are contiguous to the exterior of the building in which the business is located and that are operated by the business identified in the permit. A permit shall be valid for all decks, patios and other well-defined outdoor serving areas that are contiguous to the exterior of the building in which the business is located, that are operated by the business and only for a business operating under the name identified in the permit.

For purposes of this subsection, “controlled” as referenced above may be evidenced by a showing of the area contained within the lease agreement, even if not exclusive to the permittee and which could contain common areas, throughout which the permittee has access; or other information as the Beer Board finds acceptable.

Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. 57-4-101(p), if more than one (1) entity permitted pursuant to Sec. 8-209 operates within the same building or facility, the designations of premises may overlap; provided, that each entity serves beer in a glass or cup identifying the entity selling the beer for on-premises consumption. If an entity is seeking a permit for on-premises consumption for a premises that will include non-exclusive, overlapping areas with one or more other permitted entity(ies) in the same building or facility, the permittee must have been expressly granted the right to engage in such combination premises

activity by the property owner. This may be evidenced by a showing of such express right in the lease agreement. Such proof must be submitted with the permit application.

SECTION II. That the Franklin Municipal Code, Title 8, Section 210 be amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding the following as new subsection (b), with new text being underlined:

(b) If the area comprising the premises for an existing permit holder is altered or changes permanently from the premises description provided in the original permit application, and/or if the premises for such a permittee is amended to include common areas that overlap with other permittees in the same building or facility, the business must submit a new permit application noting their original permit approval and the change in premises.

SECTION III. BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on second and final reading, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Franklin, Tennessee, requiring it.
