He has organized golf events and dinners in the past. He is working with the director of the McConnel House and using their approved vendors.

Matthew Powell, Executive Director of the Autism Foundation of Tennessee, Inc., was in attendance to answer questions for the Committee. This is the second year for this event.

Alderman Hanson asked Mr. Powell to tell the Committee about the organization. The Foundation operates under D/B/A Autism Career Training, and they provide independent living skills, pre-employment, and employment skills to young adults and adults on the autism spectrum. Songs for the Spectrum is their largest event of the year where they fundraise between 40-50% of their annual budget. They are working with three different catering companies to get quotes for the event with licensed bartenders, and they have already acquired liquor licenses from the State of Tennessee. They have an insurance policy in place for the event as well.

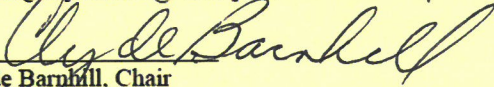
A motion was made by Alderman Potts, seconded by Alderman Hanson, to Approve the Permit. The motion passed unanimously.
