RESOLUTION 2020-84

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE BEER BOARD SHALL MEET ON JUNE 9, 2020, AND CONDUCT ITS ESSENTIAL BUSINESS BY ELECTRONIC MEANS RATHER THAN BEING REQUIRED TO GATHER A QUORUM OF THE MEMBERS PHYSICALLY PRESENT IN THE SAME LOCATION BECAUSE IT IS NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE HEALTH, SAFETY, AND WELFARE OF TENNESSEANS IN LIGHT OF THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK

WHEREAS, Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a severe acute respiratory disease that appears to occur through respiratory transmission, presents with similar symptoms to those of influenza, and can lead to serious illness or death, particularly in the case of older adults and persons with serious chronic medical conditions; and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has recommended that all states and territories implement aggressive measures to slow and contain transmission of COVID-19 in the United States; and

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2020, pursuant to the authority granted by Tenn. Code Ann. § 58-2-107, the Governor of Tennessee, Bill Lee, issued Executive Order No. 14, declaring a state of emergency to facilitate the response to COVID-1; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States, Donald J. Trump, declared a national state of emergency with respect to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, Mayor Ken Moore issued Executive Order No. 2020-01 Declaring a State of Emergency and Civil Emergency; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, Governor Lee issued Executive Order No. 16 and Executive Order No. 34 allowing electronic meetings while continuing to function openly and transparently; and

WHEREAS, Mayor Moore issued Executive Orders No. 2020-03, No. 2020-05, No. 2020-07, No. 2020-09, No. 2020-11, No. 2020-12, No. 2020-13, No. 2020-14, No. 2020-15, and No. 2020-16, continuing the Declaration of a State of Emergency and Civil Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Beer Board believes it is in the best interest of the City of Franklin to conduct the June 9, 2020, meeting by electronic means.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BEER BOARD OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

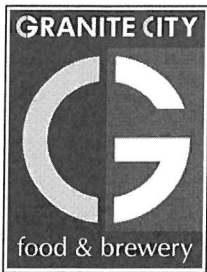

Granite City Food & Brewery Training Policy

EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENTS

- It is a condition of employment (requirement) that anybody who serves alcoholic beverages in our restaurants completes the Servsafe alcohol training. This is a mandatory part of employment at GC/CR. Some locations have local training requirements that supersede Servsafe. The training department is aware of this and then the employee would complete that program instead with same completion requirements.

TRAINING EXPECTATIONS

- Employees are required to be Servsafe alcohol certified by completing the online Servsafe training course and exam. There is a handout for all new hires that outlines the process to register and complete the training.
 - *Note: If an employee is already Servsafe alcohol certified and has a certificate to show proof of certification, they do not need to retake the Servsafe training and exam. They need to deliver certificate to managers, and they send to training.*
- The Servsafe alcohol training and exam must be completed PRIOR TO the employee working in any non-training shifts. This applies to all Servers, Bartenders, and Managers.

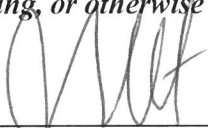

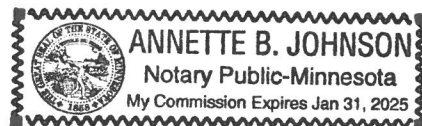

Permits shall be issued to the owner of the business, whether a person, firm, corporation, joint-stock company, syndicate, or association.

A permit is valid only for the business of the owner named in the permit.

If the business operates through a managing agent and the owner changes managing agents, it shall notify the Beer Board in writing within 30 days of the change and shall supply the name, address, drivers license number and phone number of the new managing agent. (For your convenience, a blank "change of managing agent" form has been provided in the packet).

Periodic renewal of beer permits is not required; however, there will be annual inspections for the on premises permit holders.

A permit holder must return a permit to the county or city that issued it within fifteen (15) days of termination of the business, change in ownership, relocation of the business or change of the business name. A change in ownership occurs for a corporate owner when at least fifty percent (50%) of the stock of the corporation is transferred to a new owner.

A permit is only for a single location and is valid for all decks, patios, and other outdoor serving areas that are contiguous to the exterior of the building in which the business is located.

Where an owner operates two or more restaurants or other businesses within the same building, the owner may, in his or her discretion, operate some or all of such businesses under the same permit.

The City of Franklin also has a liquor privilege tax for selling alcoholic beverages on premises. The tax is at the same rate as the State in the manner prescribed by State law and shall be collected annually.

A copy of the sales tax certificate must be provided within 10 days of approval of the permit. If you already have it, please submit with application.

Please note that all questions must be answered on the application. Failure to do so will only delay the process. The Beer Board will not approve any incomplete applications.
