- (a) You will not sell beer or similar beverages except at the place or places for which the beer board has issued your permit.
 - (b) You will not sell beer or any like beverage except in accordance with the terms of said permit.
 - (c) If this application is made for permit to sell and not for consumption on the premises, you will not sell for consumption on the premises and not allow consumption on the premises.
 - (d) You will rigidly enforce the law against sales to minors.
 - (e) You will prohibit gambling at your establishment and understand that the conduct of such activities on the premises will result in revocation of your permit.
 - (f) You will secure a certificate or statement from the health department or health officer that the premises covered by the application meet the requirements of the ordinances of the City of Franklin and the laws of the State of Tennessee.
 - (g) You will not attempt to transfer this permit to anyone else.
 - (h) You will display this permit in a prominent place in your establishment.
 - (i) You will not sell or distribute beer between the hours of 3:00 AM and 6:00 AM (8:00 AM for on premises consumption) during the week and between the hours of 3:00 AM Sunday and 12:00 Noon Sunday (10:00 AM for on premises consumption).
 - (j) You will prohibit the congregation at your establishment of those who reasonably appear to be intoxicated, lawless, rowdy, or prostitutes.
 - (k) You will not allow any liquor with alcoholic content of greater than five percent (5%) to be consumed on the premises.

- (l) You will not allow any sale or delivery of beer for consumption on the premises outside of the building, it being the intention to prohibit the sale of beer by what is commonly known as "curb service" or "curb sales" of beer.
- (m) You will comply with all requirements of section 2-201 through 2-229 of the municipal code of the City of Franklin.

A non-refundable \$250 fee must accompany this application and the application shall be submitted at least fifteen (15) days prior to the Beer Board meeting at which it is to be considered. If the application is approved you are required to provide documentation of sales tax registration to the city within ten days of approval. Any applicant making false statement in this application shall forfeit his permit and shall not be eligible to receive any permit for a period of ten years.

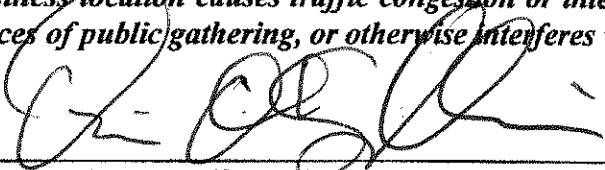
A privilege tax of \$100 is imposed on the business of selling, distributing, storing or manufacturing beer in this state effective January 1, 1994 and each successive January 1. Any holder of a beer permit issued after January 1, 1994 shall pay a pro rata portion of this annual tax when the permit is issued.

I hereby make application to the City of Franklin Beer Board for a beer permit.

The signing of this application acknowledges that I am aware of the laws prohibiting the sale of beer to minors.

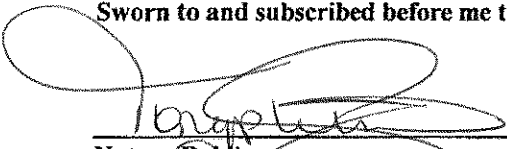

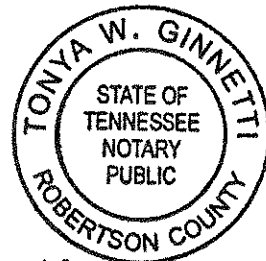

BARTENDERS

Presence behind the bar

- ❖ Walk the bar (don't just stand at side 3 talking)
- ❖ Greet people (joiners as well)
- ❖ Treat every guest as a regular
- ❖ Be available to anyone in the restaurant
- ❖ Watch to make sure everyone is greeted immediately and served within a minute of being seated
 - Walk out onto floor and get their drink order if needed
- ❖ Look attentive
- ❖ If 2 or more bartenders are working, one person should always be behind the bar
- ❖ Be on top of bussing and pre-bussing (including ashtrays)
- ❖ No cell phones behind the bar or on the floor
- ❖ No huddling together
- ❖ Create a connection with every guest
 - Tell the guest your name, ask them theirs
 - Ask where they are from
 - Where do they work
 - SMILE ☺

Take Pride in Your Appearance

- ❖ Uniform is clean black pants or shorts, Dan McGuinness t-shirt or
 - Black button down
 - Must be able to see uniform
 - Hats worn forward(no mesh hats)
 - No big logos, no language on hats
 - Jackets on MOD approval only
 - Black socks, non-slip shoes
- ❖ Be clean shaved/trimmed
- ❖ Hair fixed/combed, make-up done
- ❖ Clean clothes(no stains)
- ❖ Don't come in hung over

Teamwork

- ❖ Must complete checklist at end of shift
- ❖ Responsible for watching tables(helping clear, getting drink orders if servers are busy, etc.)
- ❖ Work your shifts, you are responsible for covering any shift you can't work
- ❖ Let servers know you rang in food
- ❖ Notice anything that we are out or that needs replaced
 - Take action and fix items
 - If something is broken, report it to MOD and write on white All board in kitchen, above stairwell

There will be a weekly cleaning checklist kept in a binder behind the bar. Every night, the bartenders are responsible for completing the items listed on that list. Each task will be dated and initialed by the bartender and checked, dated and initialed by management. If these items are not completed, there will be consequences.

Beer and Liquor service

- ❖ All servers and bartenders must have a valid ABC card for our files. If you do not present us with an ABC card within the grace period, you will be removed from the schedule.
- ❖ NEVER serve alcohol to anyone without a **VALID** ID. If you have any questions about the ID ALWAYS show ID to the manager for clarification. You can also refer to the ID booklet located under the register.
- ❖ Pay attention to your customers. Do not over serve a customer, not even a regular! Keep count of how many drinks they have ordered in a reasonable time frame. Remember, it takes one hour for one drink to fully enter your system. Be observant of behavior, speech and movements of the customer. If you feel they have had enough to drink, cut them off. If they give you a hard time, immediately find the nearest manager.

Bartender Reminders

- ❖ No drinking before or during shifts (all work must be completed)
 - Can have shift drink once clocked out and changed clothes
 - All bartenders have leadership responsibility
 - Write date on all wine bottles/boxes as soon as you open them
 - Throw away bottles after 5 days
 - Throw away boxes after 4 weeks
- ❖ Closing bartender is responsible for establishment when management isn't here
 - Complete write-up/make sure management is aware of situation and corrective measures
- ❖ Make sure check lists are complete
- ❖ NO ONE IS ALLOWED IN THE BAR AFTER CLOSE

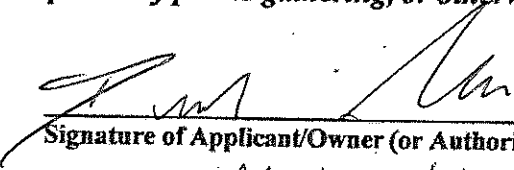

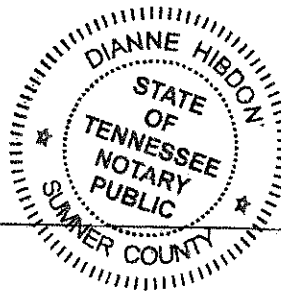

Training Policy for Alcohol Service

Some states require a picture ID for any persons drinking alcohol regardless of age. Mantra requires all guests to be asked to show proper ID. Beer is consumed on premise and will be sold as a To-Go item.

Acceptable forms of Identification

1. Driver's License with picture.
2. State issued Personal Information
3. Passport
4. An Active Military ID

Policies Concerning Responsible Alcohol Service

- The sale of alcohol to minors is prohibited.
- The legal age to purchase alcohol is 21.
- No person under 21 will be served alcoholic beverages.
- Employees must ID anyone attempting to purchase alcohol.
- The sale of service of alcohol to intoxicated customers is prohibited.
- Managers will visit any customer who has been served two (2) drinks within an hour prior to another drink being served so the manager can evaluate the customers level of intoxication.
- All employees must report incidents to a manager and document them in an incident log within an hour.
- Employees will offer to call a taxi service for the intoxicated customer at the customer's expense.
- Employees will not physically restrain intoxicated customers to prevent them from leaving the establishment.
- Employees will immediately notify a manager and will call the police to report any intoxicated customer who leaves the establishment and gets behind the wheel of a motor vehicle.
- It is against the law to serve alcohol to any person who is visibly intoxicated.
