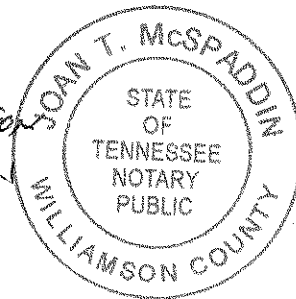

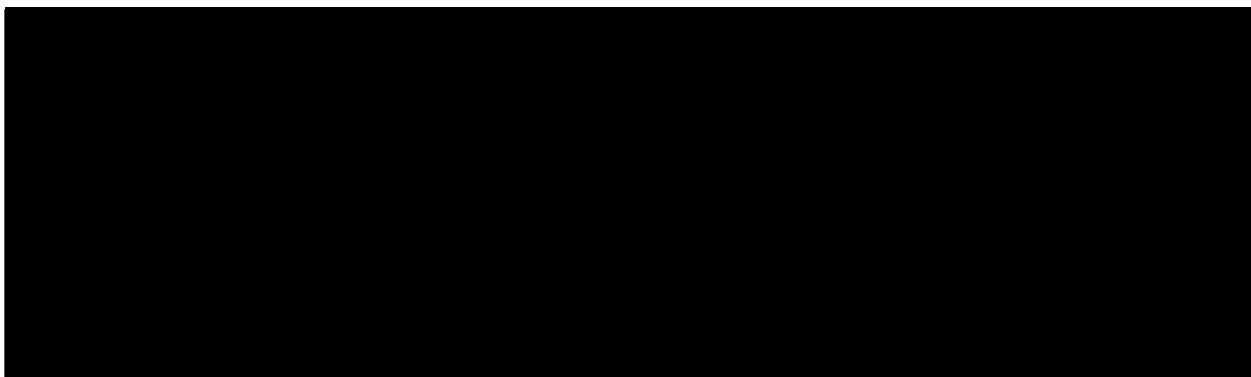

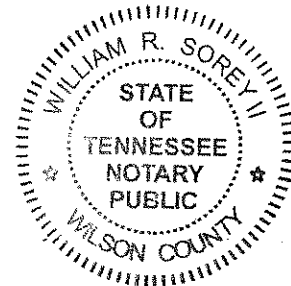

Policies Concerning Responsible Alcohol Service

- The sale of alcohol to minors is prohibited.
- The legal age to purchase alcohol beverages is 21.
- No persons under 21 will be served alcoholic beverages.
- Employees MUST ID ANYONE and EVERYONE attempting to purchase alcohol.
- The sale and service of alcohol to intoxicated customers is prohibited.
- Managers will visit any customer who has been served two drinks within an hour prior to another drink being served so the manager can evaluate the customer's level of intoxication.
- All employees must report incidents to a manager and document them in an incident log within an hour.
- Employees will offer to call a taxi service for the intoxicated at the customer's expense.
- Employees will not physically restrain intoxicated customers from leaving the establishment.
- Employees will immediately notify a manager and will call the police to report any intoxicated customer who leaves the establishment and gets behind the wheel of a motor vehicle.

Wild Wing Café® Alcohol Service Policy

It is the policy of Wild Wing Café (the "Company") that no minor (any person under the age of majority who is prohibited from being served alcoholic beverages under applicable law) or intoxicated person shall be served alcoholic beverages under any circumstances. Employees who willfully violate this policy will be terminated immediately. Any employee who negligently serves a minor or an intoxicated person will be counseled on proper service technique and will be terminated on the second violation of this policy. Employees will obtain the required Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission server permit within sixty (60) days of employment and will take the mandatory five (5) hour server training course on the responsible sale and service of alcohol as required by the Tennessee Alcoholic Beverage Commission.

Employees must request and review proper identification documentation (such as a valid state driver's license, passport or other form of identification issued by governmental authorities) for all persons ordering any alcoholic beverage. When attempting to illegally purchase alcohol, minors usually exhibit behavior that should be easily identifiable by a properly trained server or seller. As with anyone who is attempting a dishonest act, minors may appear anxious or nervous; stutter, stammer or confuse their words; avoid eye contact with the server or seller; appear overly or inappropriately friendly, confident, boisterous or outgoing.

When serving alcoholic beverages to the Company's customers, all employees shall take reasonable precautions to ensure that the person being served is legally permitted to purchase alcoholic beverages. Taking steps to prevent alcohol abuse in the Company's establishments can help protect the public from harm and keep you, as an employee, from being named in a liquor liability law suit.

As an alcohol server, you should know the laws and regulations concerning the serving and consumption of alcohol within licensed establishments. Serving minors and intoxicated persons is unlawful and may result in criminal penalties. Furthermore, if an intoxicated person, after leaving our establishment, should be involved in an accident, anyone who may be injured may file a lawsuit against you and/or the Company.

Follow some simple guidelines when serving alcohol and prevent this from happening to you or the Company. Serve one drink at a time and never bring two or three drinks at once to a single person. If someone arrives or begins to show any sign of over-consumption of alcohol or remotely appears to be intoxicated, it is your job to make sure you do not over serve the individual. The following are some suggestions of ways to slow down consumption if you suspect there is a possibility of over-serving the individual or group:

- Offer or suggest the sale of protein food or appetizers.
- Do not offer coffee or other caffeinated drink; this may cover the true extent of the

patron's intoxication.

- Suggest low alcohol content or filling drinks such as ice cream drinks.
- Serve water or fruit juices with all straight drinks.

Despite all your efforts, a customer may become intoxicated and should not be served additional alcohol. If this occurs, every effort should be made to stop alcohol service. Here are some suggestions to use when “cutting off” a customer.

- Avoid a confrontation.
- Do not attempt any physical confrontation.
- Make the manager and all personnel aware of the problem.
- Bring menus to the table or casually suggest an appetizer.
- Suggest an alternative form of transportation. If the patron insists on driving report this to your supervisor at once.

It is essential that a manager be aware of any potential situation where you, as a server, believe there is a chance of over-serving a guest or serving a minor. Remember, if a guest is over-served and leaves the restaurant and hurts someone, the authorities may likely hold you responsible along with the Company and management of the restaurant. It is possible that you could be called to court and even be subject to criminal penalties. Always remember-there is no reason over-service should occur and absolutely no reason that a minor should be served alcoholic beverages. Use your own “common sense” as well as what you have learned in your training with the Company, in your ABC Server Certification course and taking into consideration the above helpful hints.

If you follow these guidelines and act in a responsible manner, you are far less likely to be involved in any incident that may have an adverse effect on you, our patrons and the Company.

Prohibited Conduct

Alcoholic beverages may not be sold to anyone under 21 years of age.

Alcoholic beverages may not be sold to intoxicated persons.

Alcoholic beverages may not be sold to someone you suspect is buying it for underage people.

Alcoholic beverages may not be sold or consumed between the hours of

3:00 AM - 6:00 AM on weekdays or between the hours of 3:00 AM and 12:00 PM on Sunday.

(Restaurant only may serve on premises only beginning at 10:00 AM)

Checking Identification

If someone does not clearly appear to be 21 years old, ask for, look at and read their identification. If there is any question about the age or the form of identification, do not sell alcoholic beverages to that person.

Forms of identification that should be used are (1) A valid driver's license
(2) A State issued photo ID.

Check the identification to make sure there have not been any alterations of any kind, especially to the date of birth, such as any erasures, type style that does not match, or damaged paper surfaces. Also check for signs of altered signature. Compare the photo on the identification and the physical characteristics shown on the identification.

Check for counterfeit drivers licenses. They are completely different from the actual license; however they are designed to look like the valid state license.

Possible actions to take

If the ID proves the customer to be underage or there is a doubt about legally selling to this person, it is best to move the product out of reach and sight of the customer and explain why you cannot legally sell the product with something like "I'm sorry, but law says cannot sell you alcohol if you appear to be (underage), (intoxicated), (using false ID), etc.

Stay in control. This will show the offender, as well as other customers, that you know what to do and you are in control.

Police may be needed in some cases. If the customer becomes violent and/or makes threats, call 911 for the police.

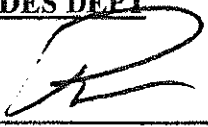

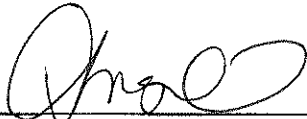

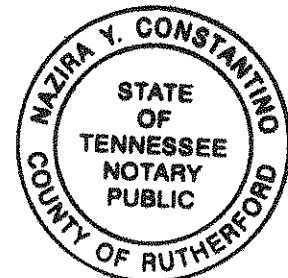
