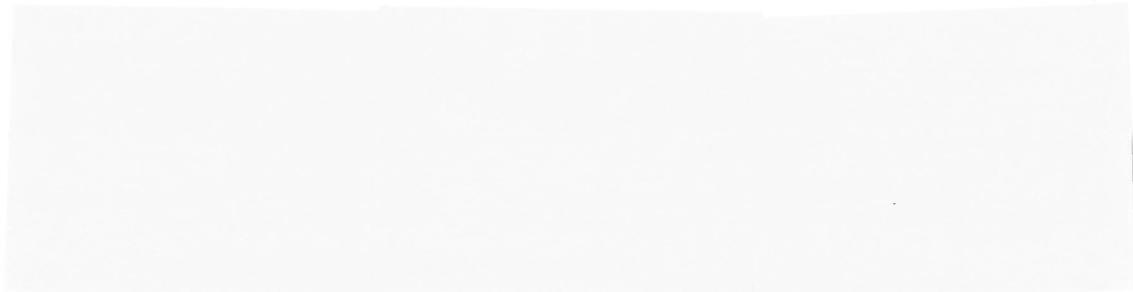

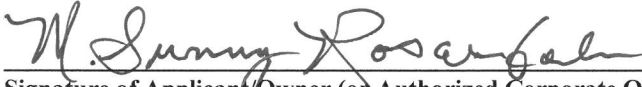

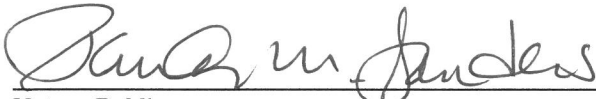

Alcohol Training Program

PROHIBITED CONDUCT

- Alcoholic beverages may not be sold to anyone under 21 years of age
- Alcoholic beverages may not be sold to intoxicated persons
- Alcoholic beverages may not be sold to someone you suspect is buying it for underage people
- Alcoholic beverages may not be sold or consumed between the hours of 3:00am and 6:00am on weekdays or between the hours of 3:00am and 10:00am on Sunday

CHECKING IDENTIFICATION

- If someone does not clearly appear to be 21 years old, ask for, look at and read their identification. If there is any question about the age or the form of identification, do not sell alcoholic beverages to that person.
- Forms of identification that should be used are (1) a valid driver's license (2) a state issued photo ID
- Check the ID to make sure there have not been any alterations of any kind, especially to the date of birth, such as erasures, type style that does not match, or damaged paper surfaces. Also, check for signs of altered signature. Compare the photo on the ID and the physical characteristics shown on the ID
- Check for counterfeit driver's licenses. They are completely different from the actual license.

POSSIBLE ACTIONS TO TAKE

- If the ID proves the customer to be underage or there is a doubt about legally selling to this person, it is best to move the product out of reach and sight of the customer and explain why you cannot legally sell the product with something like, "I'm sorry but the law says I cannot sell you alcohol if you appear to be underage, intoxicated, using false ID, etc,
- Stay in control. This will show the offender, as well as other customers, that you know what to do and you are in control.
- The police may be needed in some cases. If the customer becomes violent and/or makes threats call 911 for the police.

Permits shall be issued to the owner of the business, whether a person, firm, corporation, joint-stock company, syndicate, or association.

A permit is valid only for the business of the owner named in the permit.

If the business operates through a managing agent and the owner changes managing agents, it shall notify the Beer Board in writing within 30 days of the change and shall supply the name, address, drivers license number and phone number of the new managing agent. (For your convenience, a blank "change of managing agent" form has been provided in the packet).

Periodic renewal of beer permits is not required; however, there will be annual inspections for the on premises permit holders.

A permit holder must return a permit to the county or city that issued it within fifteen (15) days of termination of the business, change in ownership, relocation of the business or change of the business name. A change in ownership occurs for a corporate owner when at least fifty percent (50%) of the stock of the corporation is transferred to a new owner.

A permit is only for a single location and is valid for all decks, patios, and other outdoor serving areas that are contiguous to the exterior of the building in which the business is located.

Where an owner operates two or more restaurants or other businesses within the same building, the owner may, in his or her discretion, operate some or all of such businesses under the same permit.

The City of Franklin also has a liquor privilege tax for selling alcoholic beverages on premises. The tax is at the same rate as the State in the manner prescribed by State law and shall be collected annually.

A copy of the sales tax certificate must be provided within 10 days of approval of the permit. If you already have it, please submit with application.

Please note that all questions must be answered on the application. Failure to do so will only delay the process. The Beer Board will not approve any incomplete applications.

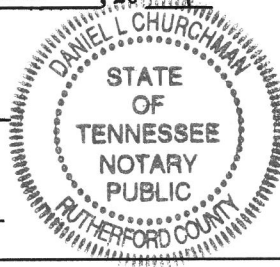

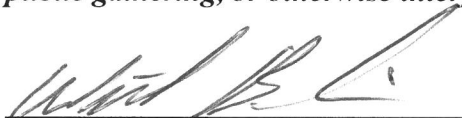

Alcohol Service Policy

1. All FBH employees will be trained on the proper sale of alcoholic beverages and be certified via the Training for Intervention Procedures – TIPS online server certification program.

 - f. Managers will visit any customer who has been served two drinks within an hour prior to another drink being served so the manager can evaluate the customer's level of intoxication
 - g. All employees must report incidents to a manager and document them in the FBH Alcohol Incident Log within an hour of the incident
 - h. Employees will offer to call a taxi service for an intoxicated customer at the customer's expense
 - i. Employees **will not** physically restrain intoxicated customers from leaving the establishment
 - j. Employees will immediately notify a manager and will call the Franklin PD to report an intoxicated customer who leaves the establishment and gets behind the wheel of a motor vehicle
 - k. It is **AGAINST THE LAW** to serve alcohol to any person who is visibly intoxicated
3. The **ONLY** acceptable form of Identification are as follows:
 - a. Valid state driver's license with picture
 - b. Valid state issued Personal Identification
 - c. Valid Passport
 - d. Valid Active Duty Military Identification
4. The FBH has a zero tolerance with improper alcohol service. One mistake with proper alcohol service will result in termination.

- (c) If this application is made for permit to sell and not for consumption on the premises, you will not sell for consumption on the premises and not allow consumption on the premises.
- (d) You will rigidly enforce the law against sales to minors.
- (e) You will prohibit gambling at your establishment and understand that the conduct of such activities on the premises will result in revocation of your permit.
- (f) You will secure a certificate or statement from the health department or health officer that the premises covered by the application meet the requirements of the ordinances of the City of Franklin and the laws of the State of Tennessee.
- (g) You will not attempt to transfer this permit to anyone else.
- (h) You will display this permit in a prominent place in your establishment.
- (i) You will not sell or distribute beer between the hours of 3:00 AM and 6:00 AM (8:00 AM for on premises consumption) during the week and between the hours of 3:00 AM Sunday and 12:00 Noon Sunday (10:00 AM for on premises consumption).
- (j) You will prohibit the congregation at your establishment of those who reasonably appear to be intoxicated, lawless, rowdy, or prostitutes.
- (k) You will not allow any liquor with alcoholic content of greater than five percent (5%) to be consumed on the premises.

- (l) You will not allow any sale or delivery of beer for consumption on the premises outside of the building, it being the intention to prohibit the sale of beer by what is commonly known as "curb service" or "curb sales" of beer.
- (m) You will comply with all requirements of section 2-201 through 2-229 of the municipal code of the City of Franklin.

A non-refundable \$250 fee must accompany this application and the application shall be submitted at least fifteen (15) days prior to the Beer Board meeting at which it is to be considered. If the application is approved you are required to provide documentation of sales tax registration to the city within ten days of approval. Any applicant making false statement in this application shall forfeit his permit and shall not be eligible to receive any permit for a period of ten years.

A privilege tax of \$100 is imposed on the business of selling, distributing, storing or manufacturing beer in this state effective January 1, 1994 and each successive January 1. Any holder of a beer permit issued after January 1, 1994 shall pay a pro rata portion of this annual tax when the permit is issued.

I hereby make application to the City of Franklin Beer Board for a beer permit.

The signing of this application acknowledges that I am aware of the laws prohibiting the sale of beer to minors.

I hereby certify that no person having at least a 5% ownership interest, nor any person to be employed in the distribution or sale of beer in my establishment has been convicted of any violation of the beer or alcoholic beverage laws or any crime involving moral turpitude within the past 10 years.

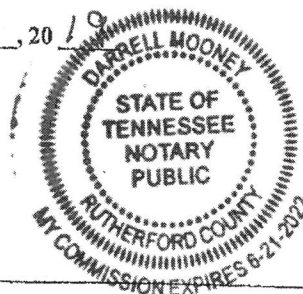

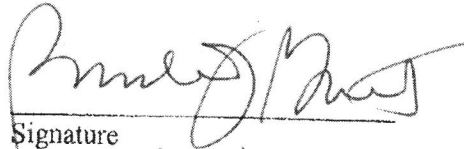
