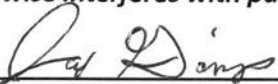

I understand that an annual privilege tax of \$100 is imposed on the business of selling, distributing, storing, or manufacturing beer and I shall remit the tax on or before January 1 of each year. Further, I understand that failure to remit the tax by February 1 shall result in automatic revocation of the license and a penalty of \$50.00 per day until the tax has been paid in full.

I understand that making false statement in this application shall precipitate forfeiture of permit and holder shall not be eligible to receive any permit for a period of ten years.

I am also aware that I shall not be issued a permit, or my permit shall be revoked if my business location causes traffic congestion or interferes with schools, churches, or other public places of public gathering, or otherwise interferes with public health, safety, and morals.

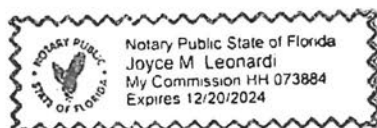

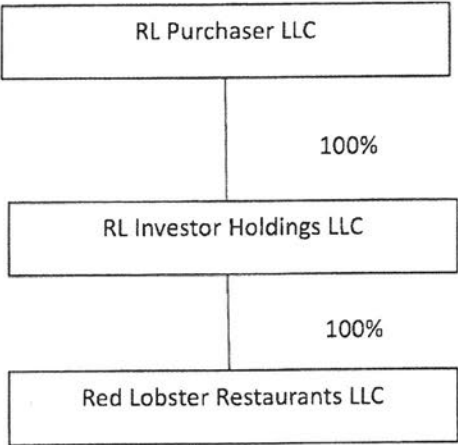

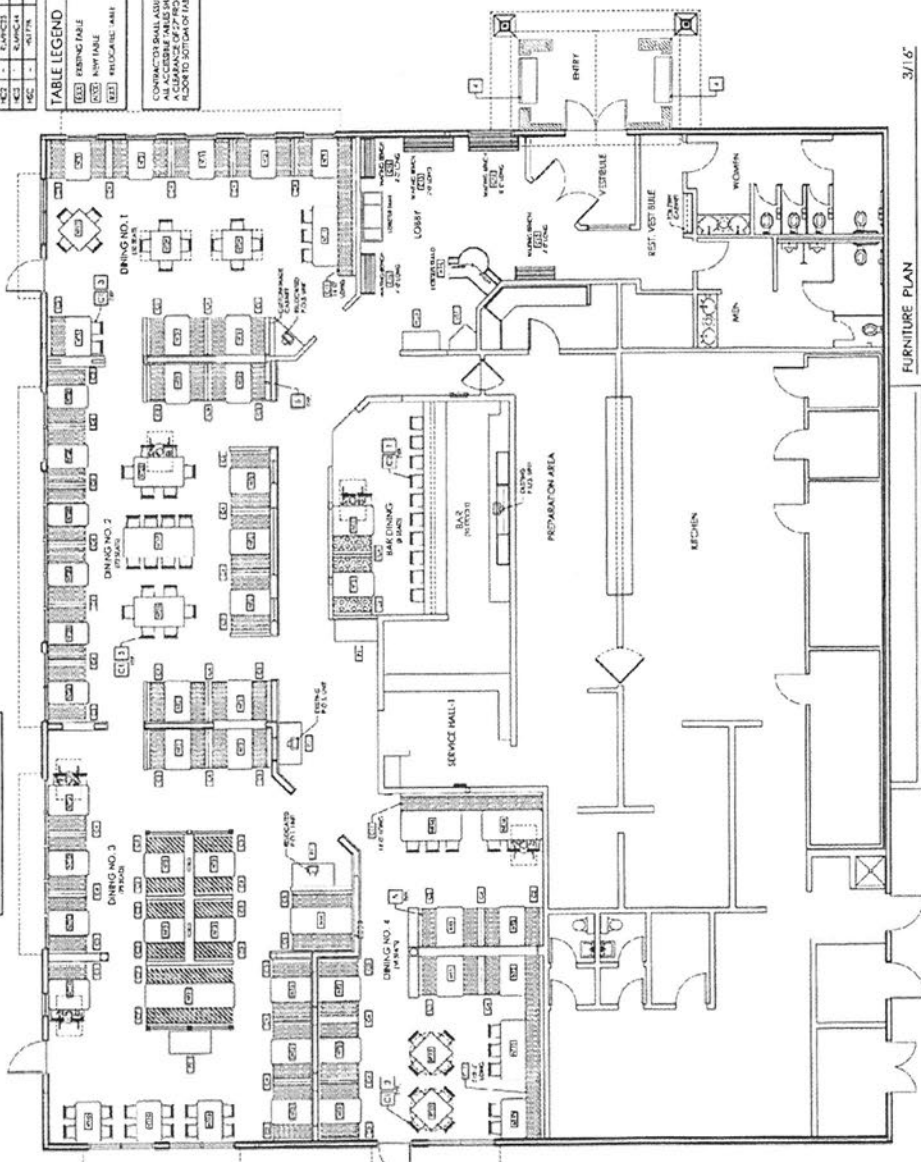

Alcohol Service Policy

Serving alcoholic beverages is a privilege granted by state, local and federal governments. We care about our guests and wish to ensure their safe return to our restaurants. Serious responsibility rests on both our employees and our Company to be sure that alcohol is served in a responsible fashion and in accordance with the law. Consequences for failing to handle this privilege in a responsible manner include legal actions, heavy fines and community service. Failure of employees to abide by policy could result in termination. The key to serving alcoholic beverages in a responsible manner is to know the law and to abide by it. Regulations vary between states and between cities. You are responsible for knowing the laws of the area(s) in which you are serving alcohol. In all cases:

- It is against the law to serve alcoholic beverages to an intoxicated person;
- It is against the law to serve alcoholic beverages to a person less than 21 years of age

In some jurisdictions, you are required to have a valid server card in order to serve alcoholic beverages. You will need to check with your manager concerning whether or not you are required to have that card in order to serve alcohol. It is your responsibility to maintain a current card where required. There are several things that you can do to be sure you are offering responsible alcoholic beverage service in accordance with the law:

- Always check identification of guests who appear to be 30 years of age or under;
- Acceptable forms of identification include a federal or state-issued photo identification reflecting the person's birth date;
- If the identification offered appears to be falsified, show it to a manager and let him or her handle the situation.
- If the identification shows the person to be under age, politely refuse alcoholic beverage service and suggest a soft drink or nonalcoholic beverage instead.
- Keep track of how much alcohol each guest has consumed, and notify a manager if any guest has consumed an inordinately large quantity of alcohol or shows signs of intoxication

In addition to the Alcohol Service Policy, team members sign off the following statements in their training after completing the Responsible Alcohol training module.

Red Lobster Seafood Co. LLC is committed to the responsible service of alcoholic beverages to responsible customers. We are also committed to protecting our team members and the community at large. All team members who may come in contact with a guest as part of their employment with Red Lobster Seafood Co. LLC, are required to follow the procedures listed.

Assessment Options: >

I must:

- Participate in alcohol awareness training when beginning employment
- Check the ID of anyone who appears to be under 30 years of age. I know that acceptable identification includes an authentic driver's license with a picture or military ID (if permitted in your state). I will check with the manager when in doubt.
- Never serve an alcoholic beverage or non-alcoholic beer to anyone under 21 years of age; anyone who is visibly intoxicated; or a known, habitual alcoholic.
- Serve alcohol in compliance with state laws.
- Immediately notify a manager if a guest shows signs of intoxication and inform a manager of circumstances under which the guest became intoxicated.
- Always discourage intoxicated guests from driving.
- Offer to call a taxi for a visibly intoxicated guest. Ask a manager to report visibly intoxicated guest's auto tag number to local police if guest insists on driving.
- I have read this policy statement, understand what is required to provide responsible service of alcoholic beverages and agree to follow these procedures. I also understand that failure to follow the procedures of this policy will be considered a basis for disciplinary action up to and including termination.
