Melissa Holland, Event Manager for GraceWorks Ministries, was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Ms. Holland explained that this is the 16th Annual Golf Fore event, which serves as a fundraiser for GraceWorks. Currently, there are about 100 golfers signed up, but they can accommodate up to 160. Donated beer will be served on the beverage carts on the course, as well as at lunch.

Chair Jason Potts arrived at 4:14PM.

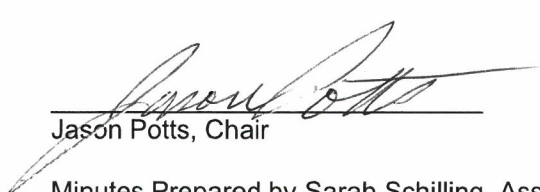
