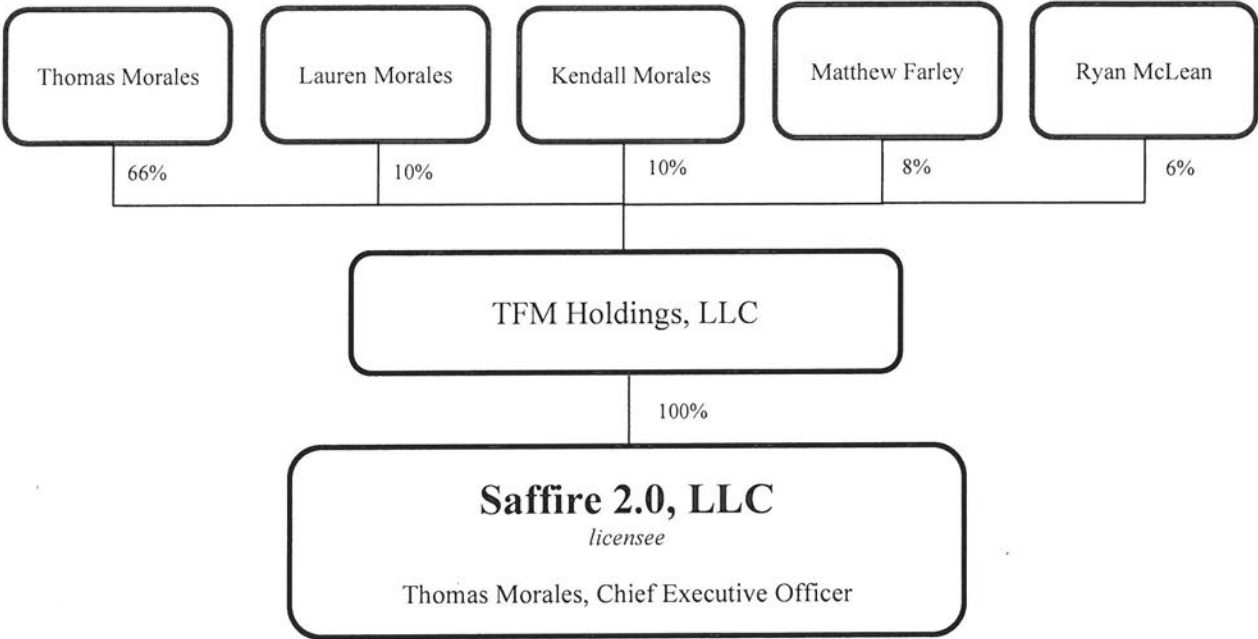

Ownership Chart of Saffire 2.0, LLC





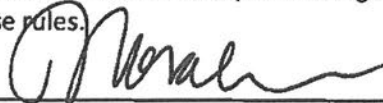
