3. **Consideration Of Application Of Friends of Franklin Parks, D/B/A Battle Of The Bourbons Polo - TN vs. KY, The Park At Harlinsdale Farm, 239 Franklin Road, Franklin, TN 37064, Kellie Baker, Managing Agent, For Special Event, Event Date And Hours: May 30, 2025 4:00 PM - 10:00 PM**

**Sponsors:**

Kellie Baker, representative for Friends of Franklin Parks, was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Ms. Baker explained that the Battle of the Bourbons polo event will take place on May 30, 2025 at the Tractor Supply Co. Arena.

*A motion was made by Alderman Clyde Barnhill, seconded by Vice Chair Greg Caesar to Approve the Beer Permit. The motion passed 3-0.*

4. **Consideration Of Application Of Friends Of Franklin Parks, D/B/A Harlinsdale Round Up/Rodeo, The Park At Harlinsdale Farm, 239 Franklin Road, Franklin, TN 37064, Kellie Baker, Managing Agent, For Special Event, Event Date And Hours: July 11-12, 2025 5:00 PM - 10:00 PM**

**Sponsors:**

Kellie Baker, representative for Friends of Franklin Parks, was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Ms. Davey explained that this is a new event for Friends of Franklin Parks. The event is hosted by A2 Events, but it will be held at the Friends of Franklin Parks Tractor Supply Co. Arena on Friday, July 11, and Saturday, July 12, 2025. Since Friends of Franklin Parks run concessions, they are responsible for obtaining beer permits. There are 1,000-2,000 people expected to attend each night.

Vice Chair Caesar asked for clarification on where alcohol and beer can be consumed.

Answer: The alcohol and beer purchase and consumption will be confined to the 8-acre property, including the grassy berms right outside the arena.

Alderman Barnhill and Vice Chair Caesar expressed concern about the parameters of the event and ensuring that no open containers leave the event area.

Ms. Davey assured the Board that Ms. Baker has been in continuous communication with the Special Events Advisory Team, which includes Parks representatives, and has been advised of best practices for events within Franklin city parks.

Ms. Billinglsey suggested posting signage at the edges of the event space that read: "No alcohol beyond this point."

*A motion was made by Vice Chair Greg Caesar, seconded by Alderman Clyde Barnhill to Approve the Beer Permit. The motion passed 3-0.*

5. **Consideration Of Application Of Westhaven Foundation, D/B/A Porchfest, Magli Green Park - Front Street, Franklin, TN 37064, Jill Tomalty, Managing Agent, For Special Event, Event Date And Hours: September 20, 2025 5:00 PM - 11:00 PM**

Mark McCutcheon, founder of the Westhaven Foundation, was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Mr. McCutcheon explained that this is the 15th Annual Porchfest, which is the Westhaven Foundation's primary fundraising event for the year.

Alderman Caesar asked if this event would be contained to the Magli Green area in Westhaven.

Answer: Yes.

*A motion was made by Alderman Clyde Barnhill, seconded by Vice Chair Greg Caesar to Approve the Beer Permit. The motion passed 3-0.*

6. **Consideration Of Application Of Mulachi South, LLC, D/B/A X-Golf Franklin, 209 South Royal Oaks Boulevard Suite 188, Franklin, TN 37064, Lilly LaFerry, Managing Agent, For On Premises Consumption**  
**Sponsors:**

Jason LaFerry, owner of X-Golf Franklin, was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Ms. Davey explained that this application is for a new business in Franklin. Mr. LaFerry stated that X-Golf is a state-of-the-art golf simulator facility with a full kitchen and full bar on premises.

*A motion was made by Alderman Clyde Barnhill, seconded by Vice Chair Greg Caesar to Approve the Beer Permit. The motion passed 3-0.*

7. **Consideration Of Application Of Fozzys Cool Springs Inc., D/B/A Fozzys Cool Springs, 600A Frazier Drive Suite 135, Franklin, TN 37067, Rodney M. Hammerstrom II, Managing Agent, For On Premises Consumption**  
**Sponsors:**

Rodney Hammerstrom, Co-owner and General Manager of Fozzy's, was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Ms. Favey explained that this application is for a new business in Franklin. Mr. Hammerstrom explained that Fozzy's is a high-end sports bar with live music, full kitchen, and full bar.

*A motion was made by Alderman Clyde Barnhill, seconded by Vice Chair Greg Caesar to Approve the Beer Permit Contingent Upon Approval of the Certificate of Occupancy. The motion passed 3-0.*

8. **Consideration Of Application Of Boots & Beer, LLC, D/B/A Boots & Beer, LLC, 306 Public Square, Franklin, TN 37064, Lorna Allison Angelillo, Managing Agent, For On Premises Consumption**  
**Sponsors:**

Jenna Burrell, Attorney for Boots & Beer, and was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Ms. Davey explained that this is a new business, but it will be located inside the Tecovas retail store on the Public Square. As part of the luxury shopping experience, customers can request a beverage, including a beer. Ms. Burrell explained that customers are limited to one beer per day per person. Additionally, everyone is carded regardless of age. There will be no liquor or wine on the premises.

Vice Chair Caesar inquired about food in conjunction to the water, soft drink, or beer during the shopping experience.

Answer: Mr. Angelillo, owner, informed the Board that bar snacks and burritos (prepared off-site in a commercial kitchen) will be available.

*A motion was made by Vice Chair Greg Caesar, seconded by Alderman Clyde Barnhill to Approve the Beer Permit Contingent Upon Approval of the Certificate of Occupancy. The motion passed 3-0.*

9. **Consideration Of Application Of NY Pie, LLC, D/B/A NY Pie, 1441 New Highway 96W, Franklin, TN 37064, Jessica Hazard, Managing Agent, For On And Off Premises Consumption**  
**Sponsors:**

Jessica Hazard, owner of NY Pie, was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Ms. Davey explained that this application is for an existing business in Franklin, but they have never applied for a beer permit. She further noted that this application is for on and off premises consumption. The idea is that customers can order beer while eating on site, or they can order a closed-container 6-pack to-go with their pizza. Ms. Hazard noted that all staff are trained to handle the sale of beer and wine.

*A motion was made by Alderman Clyde Barnhill, seconded by Vice Chair Greg Caesar to Approve the Beer Permit. The motion passed 3-0.*

**10. Consideration Of Application Of Flower Child Franklin LLC, D/B/A Flower Child, 1560 W. McEwen Drive, Suite 150, Franklin, TN 37067, Cameron Haley, Managing Agent, For On And Off Premises Consumption**

**Sponsors:**

Gabby, Assistant General Manager of Flower Child, was in attendance to answer any questions from the Board. Ms. Davey explained that this application is for a new business in Franklin. Gabby stated that this establishment would be the sixth location for Fox Restaurants in Nashville, and the 10th Flower Child location in the country. They will be selling wine and beer on site.


*A motion was made by Vice Chair Greg Caesar, seconded by Alderman Clyde Barnhill to Approve the Beer Permit Contingent Upon Approval of the Certificate of Occupancy. The motion passed 3-0.*
